

CRHS Problem Solving Team

The CRHS PST focuses on academics and student engagement. The team works to implement interventions matched to student need, monitoring progress frequently to make decisions about changes in instruction or goals, and applying child response data to important educational decisions.

Based on a problem-solving model, our team considers environmental factors as they might apply to an individual student's difficulty, and provides services/interventions as soon as the student demonstrates a need.

Focused primarily on addressing academic problems and student engagement, the CRHS PST has emerged as the new way to think about early intervention assistance for the most vulnerable, *academically unresponsive* children.

Currently the CRHS PST is working with and monitoring progress on a total of 30 students. The team consists of several highly-dedicated teachers who are trained in specific interventions. Each teacher acts as an individual mentor and strives to build a relationship with their student mentee. The team comprises multiple disciplines including the following:

- School Psychologist
- School Counselor
- Administrator
- Special Educators
- General Education English, Math, Biology/Eco Systems/ Business
